

## Permanent Part-Time Client Services Worker

The Youth Emergency Shelter Society is looking for a permanent part-time Client Services Worker for the Emergency Shelter Program.

The Shelter Program provides a service for youth that require a safe place to stay. The Shelter Program further addresses the need to provide a safe place to sleep at night and a nutritious meal. Trained staff connect with youth and provide them resources and support to make positive lifestyle changes.

**Duties:** Support the Crisis Assessment Workers and Program Supervisor with morning wake-ups, client discharges, follow-ups with outside professionals along with providing care and supervision of clients. Some light housekeeping is required as part of positive role modeling. Maintaining a safe living environment and ensuring all program expectations are met as well as other related duties are also an essential component of this position.

**Hours of Work:** 7am-12pm Mon-Fri (25 hrs/week). Some flexibility may be available to accommodate the suitable candidates schedule (i.e. post-secondary)

**Qualifications:** Working towards or have completed Diploma/Degree in Child and Youth Care or related Human services. Must have valid driver's license, First Aid/CPR and Suicide Intervention Certificate. Criminal Record Check and Intervention Check must be less than six months old. Must be knowledgeable and respectful of the cultural values, beliefs and practices of the Aboriginal culture. Previous experience is desirable.
