

## **Youth Worker**

Spirit of Our Youth Homes provides accommodation services to Aboriginal youth from across Alberta. Youth workers provide support to children and youth in group home and semi-independent living settings.

We are currently looking for qualified Youth Workers to work in our Group Care that will provide basic care to youth.

**The position includes:** Care and behavior management, crisis intervention, cultural activities, maintaining confidentiality house keeping, cooking and providing life skills through activities, education, recreation and being a positive role model.

A variety of full time, part time and relief positions are available, including days, evenings, nights, weekends and rotational shifts. When applying, please specify which type of shift you are interested in.

**The Required skills include:** Diploma in the human services field (equivalence will be considered), and knowledge of aboriginal culture.

Current (not older than 3 years at time of hire) certificates for Standard First aid/CPR, suicide intervention, non-violent crisis intervention, medication admin. (these courses are condition of employment and must be completed within 3 months of hire). Current (not older than 6 months) criminal record and child welfare checks.

Compensation is based on education and experience in the human services field. Employees are eligible for the Health Benefits/RRSP program after 6 months of employment.
